She receives extra help in school due to being on an I.E.P. Savannah is mainstreamed into regular classes, but struggles academically due to her inability to focus. Savannah often has difficulty with peers as she lacks social skills. She desperately needs a family who will persevere and care for her regardless of her diagnosis of Reactive Attachment Disorder and ADHD. Savannah's positive attributes need to be encouraged. She is in need of structure, stability, and an experienced caregiver who can deal with her manipulative behaviors. Savannah will need to have ongoing contact with her older brother who is also in care.
